Tring Park Performance Academy (TPPA) offers a wide range of classes throughout the week, incorporating the core subjects of ballet, tap and modern, along with singing, acting, jazz, contemporary, acro, street dance and progressing ballet technique (PBT). TPPA also offer adult classes in ballet, tap, pilates and Dance for Parkinson's.

TPPA also reserves the right to consider experience as well as age when placing pupils in non-syllabus classes. The following are meant as a guide only, and do not describe detailed content.

BALLET (RAD) SYLLABUS CLASSES

PERFORMERS CLASSES

These classes develop skills in singing & acting (with a musical theatre feel) with an emphasis on the creative process. Pupils are expected to come with a desire to grow and professionally develop their skills.

YOUTH DANCE COMPANY

This class focuses on choreography for performance pieces and provides additional performance opportunities at various platforms and events. To join the youth dance company, pupils must also attend a contemporary class at TPPA. The commitment to the Youth Company extends until the end of the school year to ensure the pieces that are created can be performed, particularly in the spring and summer terms.

BABY CLASSES (AGES 3+)

These classes use imaginative sequences that encourage exploration of movement to music. Young children learn about control, spatial awareness and rhythm - an introduction to all forms of dance and a preparation for graded ballet or tap and modern classes.
